UCCs Response to the Call of the SDGs

The university is located in one of the most historic and iconic cities in Ghana, Cape Coast which is known to be one of the popular tourist destinations in West Africa due to its historic sites, national park and beautiful and clean beaches. The city houses the Cape Coast Castle which was the seat of governance for the Danish, Dutch, Swedish, Portuguese, and the British colonial administrators. It was also the centre of the infamous transatlantic slave trade. <u>https://ucc.edu.gh/main/about/cape-coast-a-historic-city.</u> The University of Cape Coast is situated within half a kilometre (500 metres) of the Atlantic Ocean. This makes it one of the rarest seafront universities in the world.

The University of Cape Coast (UCC) is making history for public universities in Ghana and on the internationally. The University has been ranked the No. 1 University in Ghana and West Africa by the Prestigious Times Higher Education Rankings for four (4) consecutive years since 2021. The latest Ranking released by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings in October 2024 places UCC among the top 14th Universities in Africa and still the No. 1 University in Ghana and West Africa, respectively. The University of Cape Coast also ranks highly globally for research influence.


The University was founded by the 1st President of Ghana, Osagyefo Dr. Kwame Nkrumah in 1962 to train the much-needed teachers for the country following independence from colonisation. Since then, UCC has distinguished itself as the University of Competitive Choice in Ghana. This report presents the university's teaching, research and outreach activities that have contributed to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. The University's commitment to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) was demonstrated in the university's high ranking by the Times Higher Education Impact Ranking for SDGs 3, 4 and 14. UCC's contribution to the SDGs has been mapped using varied methodologies (see appendix). This report gives a strong indication of our academic strengths and the focus of the University. Most of the University's activities contribute uniquely to SDGs: 3, 4 and 14.



Further, the commitment of UCC towards the SDGs is evidenced by our Research Agenda (2023-2027) which has the theme "Transdisciplinary Research and Innovation for Sustainable Development in a Changing World". In this Agenda, there are six key strategic research areas that align with the 17 SDGs. These are Empowering and Transforming Society, Health in a Changing Society, Science and Technology Applications to Emerging Challenges, Responsive Distance Education, Transformative Education in the 21st Century, and Evidence Syntheses for Policy and Practice, the UCC focus and activities align perfectly with all the SDGs, and all else is equal.
